


Easter At The Chapel




- The **Jog-a-Thon** was successful again this year in meeting its goal. Many thanks to those who sponsored students.

My trials are merely a fraction of the spitting and blows Christ endured. We face these dangers for Him and with His help. For even taken altogether, these dangers don't deserve the crown of thorns which robbed our Conquerer of His crown. Yet for His sake I am crowned for a hard life. I don't consider these trial worth ... the gall or vinegar alone. But by these we are cured of the bitter taste of life. My struggles aren't worthy of the gentleness He

showed in His passion. Was He betrayed with a kiss? He corrects us with a kiss, but doesn't strike us. Was He arrested suddenly? He definitely reproves them,



but follows willingly. And if through zeal you cut off the ear, of Malchus with a sword, He will be angry and will heal it. And if one of us runs away in a linen sheet, He will defend that person. If you ask for the fire of Sodom to come down on His captors, He won't pour it out. And if He sees a thief hanging on the cross for his crime, He will bring him into paradise through His goodness. Let all who love people be loving in their actions, as

Christ was in His sufferings. Nothing could be worse than refusing to forgive our neighbor of even the smallest wrongs when God died for us.
