#### Cuba Provisioning Team

Fr Paul Howden is leading a Provisioning Short Term Mission Trip to Cuba, including our own Sam Predtechenskis! The team brought clergy stipends, generators, and medical supplies. These young men will put their professional engineering skills to work to plan several parish building projects. The pastors and churches of the Diocese of Cuba receive about \$100,000 per year for ministry assistance, given by generous friends from Canada and the US.
